Sub: Re-iteration of rules regarding forfeiture of WRF
Ref: ECR's letter no. ECR/OPT/GDS/512/15 dt 06.05.2020

ECR, vide above reference, ha requested to empower Zonal Railways for forfeiture of wagon registration fee (WRF) to check fake indents.

The matter has been examined and attention is drawn to para 201 of chapter II of Goods Tariff.

Rule 4(a) of 201 states that "No indent should be accepted for destination which has been restricted "Until Further Advise (UFA)".

Further rule 15 under 201 deals in detail about the scenarios in which WRF is to be forfeited. Note (I) of Para 15 of aforesaid rule position states that "When restriction is imposed without any time-limit the consignor shall be allowed either to retain his indent or to cancel it before removal of the restriction without forfeiture of the wagon registration fee."

Further Note 2(iii) also allows the consigner to change the destination of indent within ZR in case the destination station is affected.

Zonal Railways may take necessary action as per extant guidelines.
