No. TCII/2650/2002/Jan Shatabdi (.) It is proposed to run Jan Shatabdi Express trains, with characteristics of Shatabdi Express trains, on certain routes (.) These trains will have specially designed second class and AC Chair Car accommodation (.) The fare structure for these trains (which does not include charges for ~~packaged~~ water, newspaper, catering, etc.) is enclosed with Post Copy (.) Reservation fee and superfast surcharge will not be levied separately (.) As in the case of Shatabdi Express trains, Zonal Railways will themselves notify the all inclusive point-to-point fares, after adding safety surcharge, charges for catering services & charges for any other services provided, in these fares and then rounding off the total amount to the next higher multiple of Rs. 5 (.) Catering charges between different pairs of stations shall be calculated and notified to Zonal Railways by Catering & Tourism Directorate of Ministry of Railways (.) The details of Jan Shatabdi Express trains, their route, timings, stoppages, etc. will be notified to Zonal Railways by Coaching Directorate of Ministry of Railways (.) All other conditions/rules as applicable to Shatabdi Express trains, will apply to Jan Shatabdi Express trains also (.) Necessary instructions may be issued to all concerned immediately (.) This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of Ministry of Railways (.) Also please check these instructions and Fare structure in E-Mail box (.) Matter most urgent (.) 5. All other conditions/rules as applicable to the fares of Shatabdi Express trains will apply to Jan Shatabdi Express trains.

6. The fare shown against a distance slab applies to all the distances within that distance slab.
