Sub: Medical Pass - Provision for two attendants.

The CLW Staff Council, in their meeting held in June, 2003, has demanded that two attendants should be provided to a physically handicapped or unconscious or paralyzed or mentally retarded patient on handicapped as provided under Schedule VII item 2B(III) of Railway the same lines as provided under Schedule VII item 2B(III) of Railway Servants, Pass Rules 1986(2<sup>nd</sup> Edition 1993) to patients in big plaster, where one attendant cannot lift the patient.

- 2. The matter has been carefully considered by Board, and it has been decided by Board that when no family member is accompanying a physically handicapped or unconscious or paralyzed or mentally retarded patient, two attendants in the same class may be provided on the express recommendations of the medical officers.
- 3. In view of the above position, Railway Servants (Pass) Rules, 1986 (2<sup>nd</sup> Edition 1993) may be amended as per Advance Correction Slip No. 43 enclosed.
- In all other respects provision of Railway Servants (Pass) Rules, 1986 (2<sup>nd</sup> Edition 1993) shall apply.
- 5. This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of Ministry of Railways.
