Sub : Revision of Diversion fees.

Sanction of the Central Government is accorded to the enhancement of Diversion fees from Rs.250/- to Rs.300/- per wagons on all Zonal Railways as recommended by the Commercial Committee in their Resolution No.C-1085 held in July, 1996. It shall come into force on 1.1.97. The above diversion fee will also apply to Jute wagons on Eastern Railway.

It has also been decided that in cases where the customer's request for delivery short of destination with an undertaking that he will effect book delivery at the original destination & physical delivery at the station short of original destination under clear signature and will not claim any refund of freight for uncarried portion, no diversion fee should be levied.
