Sub: Two/multiple unloading points for Automobile Traffic (other than that loaded in rakes owned by AFTOs, and DBKMs).

Ref: Board's

- (i) Rates Circular No.19 of 2016 issued vide letter No. TCR/1015/2015/01 dated 07.06.2016 modified/ extended from time to time and last extended up to 30.11.2020 in terms of Rates Circular No.24 of 2020.
- (ii) Rates Master Circular on Block Rakes/Mini Rake/Two Point Combination etc./2020, issued vide letter No. TCR/1017/2020/03 dated 02.07.2020.

1. Board has decided to introduce two/multi point destination for Automobile Traffic, when loaded in NMG, BCCNR, BCACM or any other similar type of wagons (other than that loaded in rakes owned by AFTOs, and DBKMs). The conditions for movement of Automobile Traffic for two/multi point destination shall be as under:
 - i) Any Two/Multi Points Destination Rake shall be indented for the total number of wagons in confirmation to Block Rake Composition as notified for NMG, BCCNR, BCACM or any other similar type of wagons.
 - ii) Originating as well as all the destination stations shall be open for automobile traffic.
 - iii) A minimum of 10 wagons shall be loaded for each unloading point.
 - iv) The maximum distance between two continuous destination (unloading) points shall not be more than 500 kilometers.
 - v) The freight shall be charged as per the actual number of wagons loaded for each destination. For example:

If one NMG rake (25 NMGs) is loaded from station 'A', with 10 NMGs destined for station 'P' and 15 NMGs destined for station 'Q', the freight should be calculated as:

- (a) The freight for 10 NMGs from 'A' to 'P'
- (b) The freight for 15 NMGs from 'A' to 'Q'

Total freight = (a) + (b)
