Sub: Powers of settling claims for compensation.

In modification of Board's instructions contained in letters No. 99/TC-III/3/2 dated 23.05.2001 and No.2001/TC-III/2/3 dated 26.07.2001, it has been decided to revise the powers delegated to officers for settlement of loss and damage claims as well as settlement of accident and untoward incidents claims, as under:-

Designation	Existing Monetary Power	Revised Monetary Power
General Manager	Unlimited	Unlimited
CCM in HAG or Coordinating Head or CCO	Rs.4,00,000/-	Rs.8,00,000/-
Dy.CCM(Claims) or Dy.CCO	Rs.60,000/-	Rs.2,00,000/-
SCM	Rs.15,000/-	Rs.50,000/-
ACM	Rs. 8,000/-	Rs.25,000/-

2. It has also been decided to delegate power for sanctioning other expenses i.e. interest awarded by court, legal expenses etc. to any extent in addition to monetary powers mentioned above only in cases of train accident or untoward incidents as defined under Section 124 and 124-A of the Railways Act, 1989.
3. Other instructions contained in Board's letter No. 99/TC-III/3/2 dated 23.05.2001 remain unchanged.
4. These instructions shall come into force with effect from the date of issue of this letter.
5. This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.

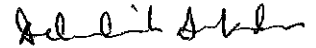

Sub :- Powers of settling decreed claims compensation cases. Enhancement of monetary powers.

Attention is invited to Board's letter No. 99/TC-III/3/2/ dated 23-5-2001 detailing the revised monetary settlement powers of officers. These powers were also to be exercised for settlement of decreed goods claims compensation cases in terms of Board's letter No. 85/TC-III/RITES/119 dated 01-4-1986.

2. It has now been decided that the powers of the Chief Claims Officers be enhanced to Rs. 4 lakhs for settlement of decreed goods compensation claims cases only in each case.
3. The other instructions contained in Board's letter No. 99/TC-III/3/2 dated 23-5-2001 remain unchanged.
4. These instructions come into force with effect from 01-08-2001.
5. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.
6. This also has the sanction of the President of India.

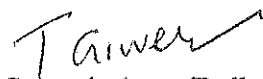

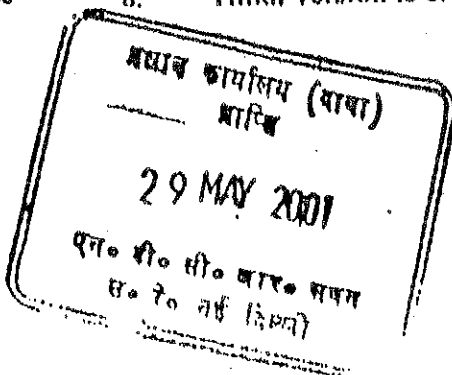
In modification of Board's instructions contained in their letter No. 94/TC-III/3/4 dated 31-10-1994 it has been decided to revise the powers delegated to officers for settlement of loss and damage claims as under:-

Designation	Existing Monetary Powers	Revised Monetary Powers
General Manager	Unlimited	Unlimited
CCM in HAG or Coordinating head	Nil	Rs. 4,00,000/-
CCO	Rs. 1,00,000/-	Rs. 2,00,000/-
Dy. CCM(Claims) or Dy. CCO	Rs. 30,000/-	Rs. 60,000/-
SCM	Rs. 15,000/-	Rs. 15,000/-
ACM	Rs. 8,000/-	Rs. 8,000/-

The above powers are also applicable in settlement of accident claims cases except in the case of CCO, who have already been delegated power vide Board's letter No. 96/TC-III/80/2 dated 31-12-97 to settle such claims upto Rs. 4 lakhs in each case.

- It has also been decided to enhance prior Accounts internal Check limit in respect of settlement of claims from Rs. 49,999/- to Rs. 74,999/-. Cases of value of Rs. 75,000/- and above shall be subjected to prior accounts check now, in each and every case.
- The enhanced delegation of powers as above shall come into force with effect from 1-6-2001.
- This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.
- This has also the sanction of the President.

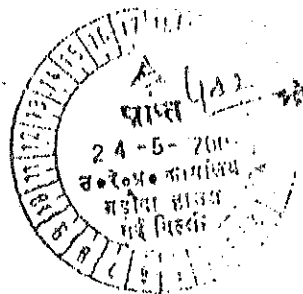
