

Sub: Bharat Tirth Trains

Board has approved the running of Bharat Tirth trains on fixed itineraries as announced in the Railway Budget 2010-11 on FTR basis excluding detention charges, empty haulage charges and notional charge for short composition. It will be operated through IRCTC. IRCTC will devise the complete package covering all off board/onboard services. The tariff for individual passengers will also be decided by IRCTC.

2. These instructions will be applicable with effect from 9.9.2010 to 8.9.2011. Concerned Zonal Railways must ensure collection of all charges prior to the running of train.

3. The above charging principles will be reviewed after one year of operation.
