- 2. Ministry of Finance Notification No. 3 of 2013-Service Tax dated 01.03.2013 and 25 of 2012 dated 20.06.2012.
- 1. Vide para 2.0 of "FM circular No. 21 of 2012 dated 28.09.2012" the following commodities exempted from payment of service tax were intimated.
- (a) Relief materials meant for victims of natural or man-made disasters, calamities, accidents or mishap:
- (b) Defence or Military equipments;
- (c) Postal mail or mail bags:
- (d) Household effects;
- (e) Newspaper or magazines registered with the Registrar of Newspapers;
- (f) Railway equipments or materials:
- (g) Agricultural produce;
- (h) Foodstuff including flours, tea, coffee, jiggery, sugar, milk products, salt and edible oil, excluding alcoholic beverages.
- 2. Ministry of Finance vide its "Notification No. 3 of 2013-Service Tax" dated 01.03.2013 has removed exemption for the following commodities:-
- (a) Postal mail or mail bags:
- (b) Household effects;
- 3. Hence as per "Notification No. 3 of 2013-Service Tax" service tax will be levied on Postal mail or mail bags and Household goods.

The above should be implemented with immediate effect.
